City Ordinance No. 2013-219

"AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS WITHIN BABAK DISTRICT DURING THE CELEBRATION OF ARAW NG BABAK/KABASAN FESTIVAL FROM MAY 25-29 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, AND PROVIDING TRAFFIC REROUTING

SCHEME THEREOF"

Be it ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the Island Garden City of Samal in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. RATIONALE. The *Kabasan* Festival, otherwise known as *Araw ng Babak*, is the summer-ender festival of the Island Garden City of Samal to commemorate the foundation of the Babak (District 1). This meaningful event is held every 28th day of May. It is a week-long celebration where Samaleños, especially people from Babak District, come to poblacion and have a good time with friends and acquaintances.

During this time of year, people from all walks of life experienced momentary escape from the monotony of life by taking part in street dancing, live bands and some get together drinking spree which will take place within the Poblacion Babak from dusk till dawn. Accordingly, in promoting the *Kabasan* Festival, the City Government deems it proper to provide areas where people can properly celebrate this momentous affair.

SECTION 2. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CITY ROADS IN BABAK. There shall be a temporary closure of city roads in Babak District, particularly, (1) from Angel Villarica Main Gate to Petron Gasoline Station, and (2) from V-Mart to Acculab every May 25 up to May 29.

SECTION 3. DATE AND TIME OF CLOSURE. The roads mentioned in the preceding section shall be temporarily closed every May 25 up to May 29 of each calendar year starting from 5:00 pm until 5:00 am.

SECTION 4. TEMPORARY REROUTING SCHEME. Any person desiring to go to nearby barangays during the closure mentioned in the preceding section shall observe the following accessible rerouting scheme:

- a) From San Agustin Road going to Barangay Tambo - use the road passing Cartagena Residence, Holy Name School, Monina Garden and exit at the Latter Day Saints Church (Mormons).
- b) From San Agustin Road going to Barangay Kinawitnon - use the street passing the Bernaldez Residence, Elena Inn, Villarica Barangay Hall and exit at Bordios Residence.
- c) From Kinawitnon going to Public Market - use the street passing Pague's residence through baywalk.
- d) From Kinawitnon going to San Agustin - use the street passing SWA, Maglasang Residence, Jala Residence, Daquipel Lechon House and exit at AZNEBO
- e) From Kinawitnon going to Tambo - use the street passing SWA, Maglasang

Residence, Jala Residence, Daquipel Lechon House, AZNEBO, Cartagena's Residence, Holy Name School, Monina Garden and exit at the Latter Day Saints Church (Mormons).

- f) From Tambo going to Kinawitnon - use the road passing the Latter Day Saints Church (Mormons), Monina Garden, Holy Name School, Cartagena Residence, Bernaldez Residence, Elena Inn, Villarica Barangay Hall and exit at Bordios Residence.

SECTION 5. The PNP Traffic Management Team and the City Economic Enterprise personnel are hereby authorized to implement this ordinance and to effect any changes of re-routing and temporary closure during the specified period if deemed proper and necessary for the smooth flow of traffic.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by court of competent jurisdiction, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any Ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this enactment is hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and posting in three conspicuous places within the city.
